  - evidence of expertise in extended excursion management and responsibility
  - excellent interpersonal skills with students
  - demonstrated expertise in historical enquiry.

The decisions of the HTAA affiliates in nominating teachers and the Simpson Prize Advisory Committee in selecting the two teachers for the trip will be final. Selected teachers will maintain a trip diary which becomes the property of the Commonwealth Government.*
