Declaration: 1. I/we declare that I am/we are the guardians / parents of

creator of the entry (from now on referred to as 'the entrant'), and shall ensure that the entrant, so far as possible, understands the statements and obligations in the following declaration. I/we make the following declaration on behalf of the entrant in relation to his/her entry.

2. I/we accept that entry into the competition is subject to the terms of this declaration and is submitted according to the rules of the Simpson Prize competition ('the competition'). I/we accept that the judges' decision is final and that no correspondence or reconsideration will be entered into.

3. I/we grant to the Commonwealth of Australia ('the Commonwealth') a permanent, irrevocable, royalty-free, non-exclusive licence (including a right of sublicense) to use, reproduce, adapt and exploit the entry from the date of submission of the entry. I/we grant a licence on the same terms in respect of any trip journal that the entrant is required to create from the time the journal is created. I/we accept that the photo or image of the entrant may be published.

4. I/we consent to any act, omission or thing by the Commonwealth or the History Teachers Association of Australia ('HTAA') in relation to the entry or any trip journal kept by the entrant that would constitute an infringement of the moral rights of the entrant of attribution and integrity of authorship.

5. The Commonwealth and the HTAA are required to comply with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth). In accordance with the Act, I/we acknowledge that the HTAA will collect certain 'personal information' about the entrant (name and address for example) for the purpose of conducting the competition.
